Criteria	Description of Criteria for Papers
<p>Organization 15% of the score for the assignment</p>	<p>Is the Research Question clearly stated? Are there five sections? Are sections given correct titles? Does content of a section match its title? Is there a title and abstract? References?</p>
<p>Grammar 15% of the score for the assignment</p>	<p>Does each paragraph have a topic sentence? Do all sentences develop one controlling idea? Does appropriate grammar (punctuation, syntax, usage)? Is the paper free of spelling errors? Are citations used appropriately?</p>
<p>Style 15% of the score for the assignment</p>	<p>Does paper avoid the passive voice? Does paper avoid use of the stated ^{stated}? Does paper avoid split infinitives? Overall, is the writing style and voice appropriate? Does it appear the student read contemporary and seminal studies and is it written in the style of the profession? <p>Content I 25% of the score for the assignment</p>	<p>A specific causal research question must relate to a relevant economics literature and good data must be used to shed light on the question.</p>
