Achieve

Achieve contains course specific content and is integrated with Canvas for single sign-on access. Students are, at a minimum, required to have access to Achieve which includes an eBook. Students can choose to purchase a print text as well at an additional cost, but it is not required.

Respondus

This course requires the use of Respondus for electronic proctoring of all exams. For online exam proctoring, it **is necessary that your computer has reliable, high-speed internet connection**. Respondus information can also be found on the course Canvas site. Online proctoring via Respondus is free for San Jose State University students.
