International House

A large, comfortable home located near campus, the International House (I-House) is a residence for 70 U.S. and international students attending San José State. At I-House, residents find friends, study partners, and mentors in addition to opportunities for leadership, group activities and travel. I-House students represent approximately 25 countries, range in age from 17 to 35 years of age, study in a wide variety of programs offered on the SJSU campus, and enroll in graduate, undergraduate, semester and year exchange, and English language programs.

Housing Costs (meal plan required)

Housing rent is based on double occupancy, furnished units with a 10-month contract. Rent includes basic utilities, wi-fi internet access, internet-based TV and furniture. To facilitate appropriate first-year course placement, the CSU evaluates your academic preparation in two areas: written communication and math/quantitative reasoning.

The evaluation takes into account several factors, including overall grade point average, mathematics grade point average, completed terms of secondary coursework, grades in certain senior year classes, reflection on college writing, and scores on standardized tests such as the SAT, ACT, CAASPP/EAP, CLEP, Advanced Placement, Advanced Level, Advanced Subsidiary, and International Baccalaureate examinations.

First Year Writing Course Placement

Freshmen entering SJSU will complete an online Reflection on College Writing exercise to explore writing at SJSU and to choose the course they need. The online exercise is offered through Canvas (SJSU's online course tool). Be alert for emails and MySJSU messages about the Reflection on College Writing. To ensure that you will be able to register for your first-year writing course during



Fees are due after registering for your classes. To see your payment due date, check your MySJSU account under the "Finances" section. You have the option to pay in full or sign up for a payment plan. For details, visit sjsu.edu/bursar

After you register, sign in to your MySJSU account to view the amount you owe and your payment due date. SJSU does not send invoices to students. It is your responsibility to check your MySJSU account to keep current with your account. Failure to pay by the deadline may result in all your classes being dropped. Coming from a U.S. Institution

To complete this process, you must do the following: Show your admission letter and the SJSU "SEVIS Transfer In Form" to your current school's international office.

This form is not mandatory but optional; it is used to let your current institution know that you wish to transfer to SJSU. Once your current institution sends your electronic I-20 document through SEVIS, then you will receive a Transfer-Pending Form I-20 from SJSU.
