

Provisional Admission

This offer of provisional admission is based on the academic information you reported on your Cal State Apply application. Your admission will remain "provisional" until you meet all terms stated below and your official, final transcript(s) passes verification.

This offer of provisional admission to the academic plan (major) listed on your admission letter is only valid for this term and may not be deferred to another semester. In addition, change of major cannot be made before the beginning of the Spring 2024 semester and is not guaranteed. You must enroll in at least one course during the Spring 2024 semester to maintain your admission.

Returning SJSU Students: All returning SJSU students must comply with all deadlines and admission requirements included in this document.

Mandatory components in the provisional admission process (within business days) as an email confirmation

Meet the CSU minimum requirements for upper division transfer admission

An internal review (verification) of your application will be conducted. Your official, final transcript(s) must show that you meet the current impact criteria and CSU transfer admission requirements in order to pass final verification. To ensure that your provisional admission passes final verification, make sure your official, final transcript(s) meets the following criteria:

- You must have an overall GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- You must be in good standing at the last college or university attended.
- You must meet the four basic skills course requirements with a grade of "C-" or higher by the end of the Fall 2023 term. A grade of "D+" or lower will not meet this requirement. SJSU will accept "Credit" or "Pass" for transferable college courses completed in Winter, Spring, Summer or Fall 2020 terms and in Winter, Spring or Summer 2021 terms to satisfy the four basic skills course requirements.
- You must complete at least 60 transferable semester (90 quarter) units by the end of the Fall 2023 term.
- You must meet the current impact criteria for your major for the Spring 2024 term this includes completing supplemental coursework with a C grade or better if required.

Be advised: If you have any outstanding documents such as official transcripts, that are past due at the time of registration, your eligibility to register could be delayed until they are received and processed (which can take up to two weeks).

Monitor Your MySJSU Account - EXTREMELY IMPORTANT

SJSU communicates almost entirely by messages and To Do List items posted to your MySJSU (one.sjsu.edu) account. Check your MySJSU account frequently for updates to your status, important messages, and invitations to upcoming events. You are responsible for compliance with all deadlines posted on your MySJSU account. Failure to do so may result in your application or admission being withdrawn even if you have signed up for housing, attended orientation, or registered for Spring 2024 classes.
