ADVANCED STANDING BY EXAMINATION

Advanced standing by examination is a procedure designed to permit the student to receive university credit in areas where he has competence but for which no course is available. The procedure is designed to permit the student to receive a wider selection of courses.

Advanced standing by examination is divided into two categories: (1) Advanced standing by examination in a specific subject and (2) Advanced standing by examination in a specific area.

1. Social Science - All students attending college must satisfy specific subject requirements in Social Science.

Students who feel they have adequate knowledge to pass a test in these areas may apply for specific examination. The examination questions which cover the three Social Science subject requirements...
