

# F74-7 REQUIREMENT OF GRADUATE RECORD EXAMINATION (GRE) A DEPARTMENT OPTION

## UNIVERSITY POLICY ON GRE APTITUDE TEST

### F 74-7

WHEREAS, Present University policy as described in the Graduate Bulletin of San Jose State University requires that all graduate students take the GRE Aptitude Test as a condition of advancement to candidacy, but permits departmental or program option on what use, if any, is made of the student scores; and

WHEREAS, Many departments do not use GRE Aptitude Test scores in determining the student's qualification for advancement to candidacy, and thus for many students the University requirement become a meaningless exercise; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the University-wide requirement of the GRE Aptitude Test as a condition for advancement to candidacy be dropped and replaced by departmental or program option for use of any other test in evaluating graduate students.
