## POLICY RECOMMENDATION ON COURSE OFFERING AND ENROLLMENT STANDARDS REPLACES SENATE POLICIES F66-3 AND F66-4

Whereas: The California State University guidelines for minimum course enrollments have

changed (March, 1982) since F66-3 was written, and

Whereas: Following the enactment of F66-4 many circumstances in the SJSU academic

environment have changed, and

Whereas: The public has a right to expect that courses listed in the SJSU catalog are

1. Once annually, after Spring census date, the Office of Curriculum and Assessment will distribute a listing of existing online and/or printed Catalog courses that have not been offered for at least two calendar years. A course that was scheduled for offering, but then cancelled, shall be considered not to have been offered.
