Amendment C to University Policy S14-5, Guidelines for General Education (GE), American Institutions (AI), and the Graduation Writing Assessment Requirement (GWAR)

Legislative History:

At its meeting of December 7, 2020, Senator White presented Amendment C to University Policy S14-5 for the Curriculum and Research Committee. Amendment C to University Policy S14-5, Guidelines for General Education (GE), American Institutions (AI), and the Graduation Writing Assessment Requirement (GWAR) requires the GE Guidelines to be updated to include a 3-unit Area F, Ethnic Studies requirement effective Academic Year 2021/22, and lower the Area D division requirements from 9 units to 6 units to be in alignment with Title 5.

ACTION BY UNIVERSITY PRESIDENT:

Approved and Signed by President Mary A. Papazian on December 8, 2020.

Per Title 5, the lower division Area D requirement will be reduced from 9 to 6 units, and as such, there will be a significant impact on faculty and FTES in that area. There is the potential for lecturers to lose their jobs as a result. There may be a temporary increase in advising workload for departments due to catalog rights of students who will continue to need 9 units to fulfill Area D requirements.
