Amendment F to S15-7, Retention, Tenure and Promotion for Regular Faculty Employees: Procedures Regarding Department

Chair Participation ontte Electron to the new RTP policies. These amendments relate to a clause in the Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) about the participation of Department Chairs on department RTP committees. For reference, that clause reads as follows:

15.40 b. Department chairs may make separate recommendations. Such recommendations shall be forwarded to subsequent levels of review.

POLICY RECOMMENDATION Amending

S15-7, University Policy, Retention, Tenure and Promotion for Regular Faculty Employees: Procedures

3.2.9 Department Chair participation. A Department Chair is eligible to serve on the department committee, and if elected to the committee the Chair of the Department shall serve as Chair of the committee and shall not write a separate Chair's recommendation. If the Chair is not elected to the department committee or if the Chair declines to serve on the committee then the Chair may shall-write a separate recommendation. The Chair of the Department may participate in either capacity only if he/she is of sufficient academic rank as per 3.2.5. Such recommendations shall be forwarded to the college level along with the recommendations of the department committee and any responses to the departmental level recommendation(s) supplied by the faculty member.

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
