RESOLUTION

Academic Council of
San Jose State College
March 22, 1965

WHEREAS, approximately one thousand students were accepted for admission to San Jose State College during the academic year 1965-1966 and

WHEREAS, that which was accepted by the Governor's "Bare Bones" budget proposed for 1965-1966,

and the Board of Regents has not provided for the additional students to be accepted during the academic year 1965-1966,

and whereas San Jose State College has been allotted a budget for 15,222 F.T.E. students (based on a faculty of 925 F.T.E. positions); now,

Be it therefore resolved that the Academic Council of San Jose State College requests that the number of students accepted for admission during the academic year 1965-1966 be limited to the number of F.T.E. students not exceed

salary savings and any other forms of budget limitations have been deducted; and be it,

RESOLVED: that if applicants for admission and/or readmission must be accepted into credential, certificate, and undergraduate degree programs; and (2) undergraduate students as uncertain.
