**SENATE MANAGEMENT RESOLUTION
CREATING A METHOD FOR REVIEWING
TWO REPORTS RELATED TO ACADEMIC PRIORITIES**

Whereas, The Provost of the University has requested that the Senate offer its advice on two reports related to Academic Priorities: the reports of the Redesign Task Force and of the Academic Priorities Steering Committee; and

Whereas, Among other ideas, the Senate retreat suggested that an ad hoc committee be formed to prepare the Senate for a full discussion of these reports; now therefore, be it

Resolved, A special ad hoc committee, called the "Senate Academic Priorities Review Committee" be created as follows:
