Senator Buzanski AS 1139 Sense of the Senate Resolution Departmental Relations with Retired Faculty

from the floor.

Senator Buzanski explained the necessity of such a proposal, stating that many retired faculty have passed away in recent years and that the campus community had not been informed in many instances. Senator Buzanski noted that many departments have simply lost contact with retired faculty due to a number of factors in the university.
