## 1. Chair's Update:

Chair Mathur acknowledged the passing of Justice Ruth Bader-Ginsburg. She also acknowledged September 21<sup>st</sup> is the United Nations' International Day of Peace, with non-violent observation and cease fires across the world. Chair Mathur announced that VP Faas had been called away for last minute

A: The President authorized a new investigation at the Chancellor's Office level. SJSU is not conducting the investigation. There is no retaliation by anyone. Five separate investigations have been launched with no findings of wrongdoing on our part. The students, staff, etc. have all been contacted and interviewed again as part of the Title IX investigation that has also been moved to the Chancellor's Office.
