

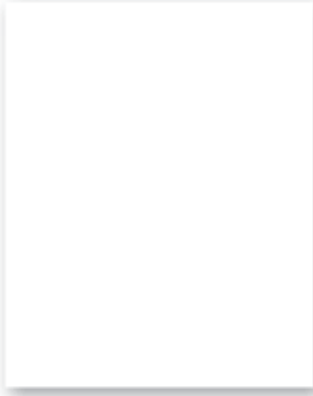

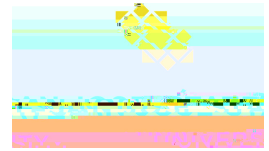

Ms. Jaffe received a B.A. and M.A. in Philosophy from Kiev National University in Ukraine, a J.D. from Rutgers University School of Law, and a LL.M. in Taxation from New York University School of Law.
