Congratulations! The Chancellor's Office has reviewed and approved the Implementation Plan for California State University, San Jose ("SJSU" or "University"). This included an assessment and recommendation by the Office of Civil Rights Programming and Services, and final review and approval by Chancellor García. I would like to thank you and the implementation team for creating an Implementation Plan that addresses the recommendations of the Cozen O'Connor assessment.

At this time, the Chancellor's Office is finalizing a public facing document for the Implementation Plan to be posted on the University's website. It is critically important that the format of the publicly available Implementation Plan for each campus be consistent across the CSU system. The Chancellor's Office will populate a template for your campus based on the Implementation Plan previously submitted. Once this process is complete, the Systemwide Director assigned to SJSU, Alex Pursley, will provide the public facing Implementation Plan to the Title IX Coordinator / DHR Administrator for review and finalization. Upon your approval of the final product, the public facing Implementation Plan should be posted on the University's website.

The University should continue to implement the plan while the public facing Implementation Plan is being developed. The Systemwide Director will continue to be available to support the University to ensure that the recommendations are implemented in a timely manner.

The Chancellor has requested periodic, written status updates be submitted for each campus outlining their progress on the Implementation Plan. Accordingly, status reports must be submitted to the Systemwide Director twice per year on December 1 and June 1. The Office of Civil Rights Programming and Services will distribute a template for the campuses to use for status reports on or before September 1, 2024.
