

SPECIAL CONSULTANT

Special Consultants must have extensive, demonstrated experience in the particular area or specialty in which services are required. The incumbent must have successfully applied a variety of knowledge and skills in achieving similar objectives.

The work performed by a Special Consultant is non-bargaining unit work. The Special Consultant is paid at a daily or hourly rate and is paid once per month. Appointment as a Special Consultant shall not exceed one year.

Special Consultants must be certified as eligible to work under the provisions of the Immigration Reform and Control Act. They are covered by workers' compensation and unemployment insurance through the University. They do not accrue benefits such as sick leave, vacation, health and dental
